

**Proposal for ACS National Meeting Symposium
ACS Division of Biological Chemistry**

The ACS Division of Biological Chemistry (DBC) invites proposals for symposia to be organized as part of the biological chemistry programming (BIOL) at one of the two 2018 ACS National Meetings. Organizers must be members in good standing of the DBC. Please submit a brief proposal (this completed interactive PDF) no later than **February 15, 2017** for consideration in the Spring 2018 meeting and no later than **July 25, 2017** for the Fall 2018 meeting to Shana Kelly (shana.kelley@utoronto.ca). **Late submissions will not be considered.** Proposals are evaluated biannually, so there is an advantage to sending proposals in as early as possible (especially since some meetings can receive too many proposals). BIOL will generally provide \$3000/session to help defray expenses of speakers (registration and travel) in non-award sessions. Funds must be allocated equally between speakers.
